And with the folks be handy

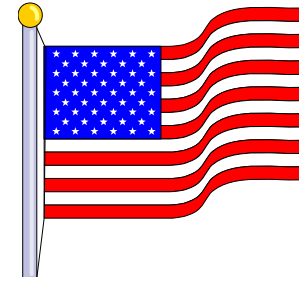
